# \*The Youth Sociotherapies Centres (MOS)

are intended for children and teenagers who because of failure to succeed, problems with learning and antisocial behaviour are threatened with social maladjustment and require special organization of learning, methods of work, upbringing and sociotherapies. Eliminating causes and signs of behavioral disorder and preparing foster children for life in accordance with social and legal standards are included in MOS tasks.



# \*The Youth Sociotherapy Centre in Ustka town

is a public, co-educational youth institution which provides a boarding school at the level of secondary education. Students at the age from 13 to 18 participate in didactic and educational activities. Classes consist of no more than 12 students. The didactic process is organized on the basis of national curricula and the teaching plans for secondary education under the authority of the Ministry of Education. The institution staff strives to make our graduates build their own careers and plans for the future and succeed in their personal achievement, and also be able to cooperate and understand the idea of work for the society, as well as refer to universal, ethical values of life.

## \* The Vocational Training Programme objective

Teaching participants to perform a determined work in a chosen profession, confirmed with a certificate





**\* „The MOST Program” consists of two modules which complement each other: The Life Alternatives Training and The Vocational Training Programme with The Training for Work: “The Assistant of.....”.**

**\*The program is derived from data and current trends in effective, open resocialization, which is based on carrying out the tasks in the open social environment out of the institution.**

**\*The sociotherapy in an actual place of work strengthens the main aim of the process: social reintegration, readaptation and an opportunity to fulfill social roles. A vital part of this program is bringing in particular craftsmen houses, which may find it as an opportunity to gain trained employees and develop their own businesses.**

- \* **The Vocational Training Programme: 322 h (most of them at the workplace)**
